History

In 1990, the Southwestern administrative team envisioned a Foundation to benefit the students of the Southwestern district. An administrative initiative was established and a request was submitted for a \$1,000 grant to help in the study of school foundations. Over the next 10 years, the idea of a non-profit school foundation took root and finally came into being in June, 2000. The \$1,000 study grant has grown into an organization that has produced several

hundred scholarships for students and has provided thousands of dollars in special event and mini-grant funding.

The following is the vision statement that was developed by the founders in June 2000:

- The Southwestern Foundation for Educational Excellence is proposed as a non-profit, tax exempt organization founded for the exclusive purpose of providing supplemental funding for educational projects that will encourage Southwestern Community Unit School District No. 9 students, teachers, administrators, and other members of the educational community to strive for higher levels of academic excellence. This foundation is intended to work in close harmony with the Southwestern Board of Education while remaining independent of their jurisdiction in matters relating to fund raising and the expenditure of the organization's assets.
- This Corporation, founded as an educational support foundation, shall operate as an autonomous, non-profit organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. As such, the Foundation shall act as a channel through which tax-exempt donations may be accepted for educational projects that benefit members of the Southwestern Educational Community.
- The Foundation shall be governed by a volunteer Board of Directors who represent the
 community by donating their expertise in business, professional, educational,
 agricultural, and domestic matters in the operation of this corporation. Although the
 Corporation and the Southwestern Board of Education are separate and distinct entities,
 they shall work in close harmony with each other in a complimentary manner that
 provides educational benefits for the School District.

Mr. George Lahr served as the first President of the organization. Founding members included: Ken Archer, Terry Buhs, Don Burch, Dan Clasby, Webb Cunningham, Don Kruse, George Lahr, Ken Loy, Tom Ryder, Kent Scheffel, Larry Stewart, and Don Stuckey.

Scholarships

Hundreds of Southwestern graduates and their families have benefitted from scholarships provided by the Southwestern Foundation. Donations

Approximately \$500,000 has been donated toward classroom projects and scholarships since the Foundation's inception in 2000 as a non-profit, 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization. The Foundation encourages higher levels of academic excellence within the Southwestern district, while remaining independent in matters related to Foundation fund-raising and expenditures.

Funding for the Foundation's work has come primarily through its events, memorial donations, and payroll deduction contributions from district employees. Gifts are tax deductible, and a representative would be pleased to talk with you or your tax advisor about a donation or making the Southwestern Foundation a part of your estate planning.

Donating to the Southwestern Foundation

Gifts to the Foundation take many forms. Representatives of the organization can assist you or your representative in developing a plan that works for you.

- Individual Donations: Scholarships, projects, or programs can be funded through one-time gifts or ongoing donations. The Foundation has worked with donors on all types of gifts and offers the flexibility to give in a format that meets your goals.
- Matching Gifts: If you're involved with a company or organization that has a matching gift program, the Foundation can provide the documentation and assistance to procure the donation. A matching gift produces major benefits for students.
- Memorials: The Southwestern Foundation is the recipient of many memorials. The
 Foundation works with funeral directors and individuals in establishing memorials, and
 ensures the desired recognition for the person being remembered.
- Legacy Gifts: Current and future Southwestern students will benefit through estate gifts
 or endowments. The Foundation and its tax and legal representatives will work with
 you to assist in planning a substantial donation. The coordination between your
 advisors and the Foundation representatives enables you to receive the necessary
 benefits while offering long-term opportunities to students.

The Impact of Your Gift

Donors to the Southwestern Foundation see the benefits of their gifts on an annual basis. Scholarship recipients, teachers and mini-grant projects, and special programs funded through the Foundation are highlighted at the organization's events. The events recognize the people and activities that make Southwestern special.

- Scholarships: Funding for scholarships can be based on the donor's wishes. Grade point
 averages, careers or occupations, specific college or universities, specific academic
 programs, or other criteria can be used in establishing scholarships. Donors have the
 opportunity to select the eligibility requirements and the number of years the
 scholarship will be offered. Scholarships can be funded for one year, or an endowment
 or reoccurring gift can fund a scholarship on a long-term basis.
- Mini-grants: Southwestern students of all ages have experienced the benefits of minigrants. Teachers apply for the grants to fund special projects. The result is new educational opportunities that are created through Foundation funding. Mini-grants can be funded in the same manner as scholarships with the donor determining the parameters and length of the funding.
- Special Programs: These programs are usually offered to an entire school or specific grade levels. The programs are unique educational experiences and are the type of events students remember. The scholarship and mini-grant funding flexibility also exists for special program donations.

Stewardship of Your Donation

The Southwestern Foundation values our supporters and works diligently to care for their gifts. Funds are invested in guaranteed income accounts to help gifts grow while also protecting their value. The balance of each memorial, major gift, and legacy fund donation is monitored and balances can be provided on an annual basis.
